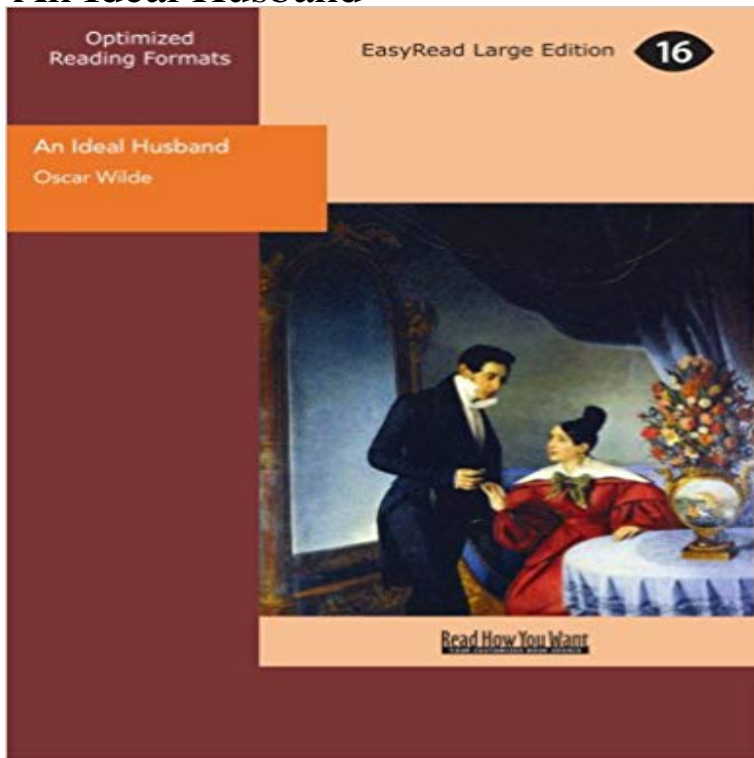


An Ideal Husband
