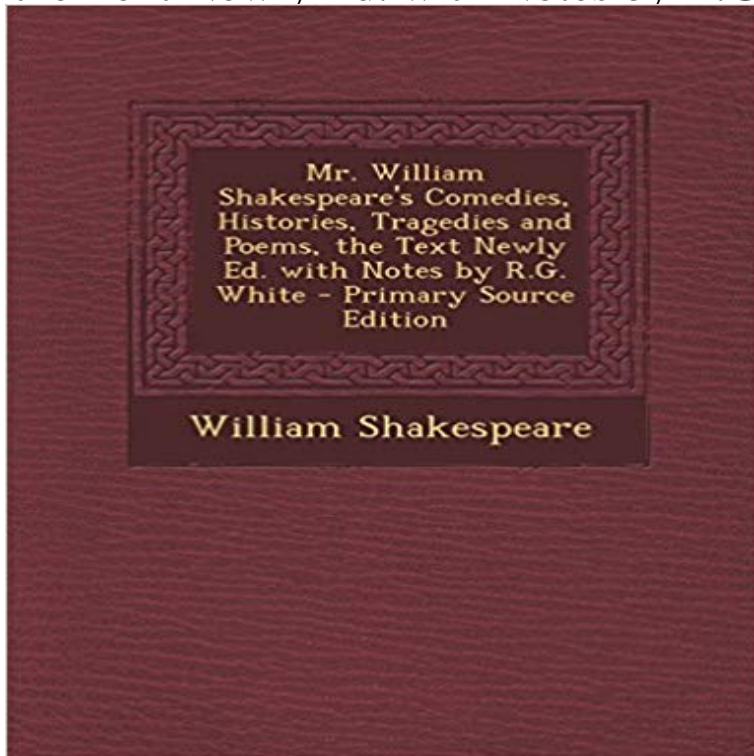


Mr. William Shakespeares Comedies, Histories, Tragedies and Poems, the Text Newly Ed. with Notes by R.G. White - Primary Source Edition
