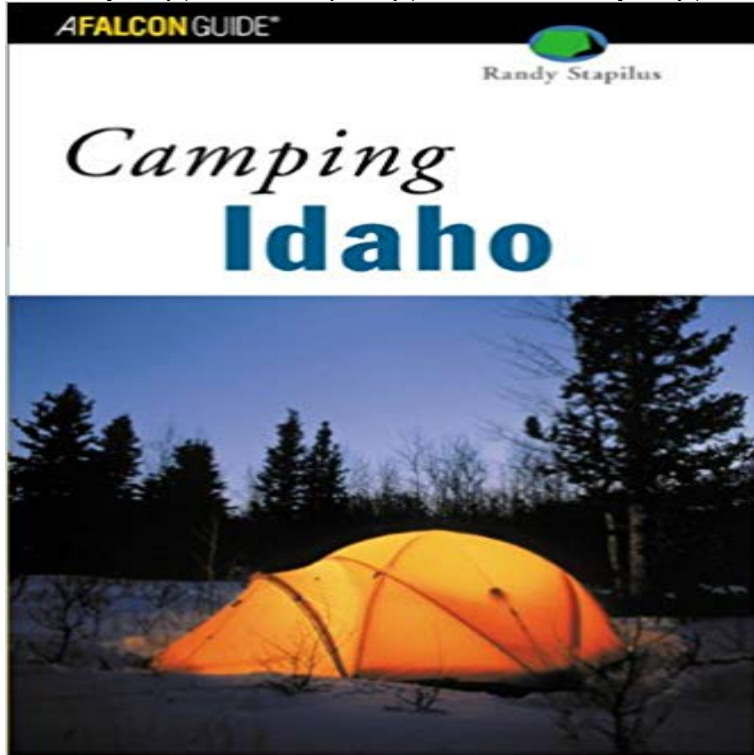


Camping Idaho (Regional Camping Series)
