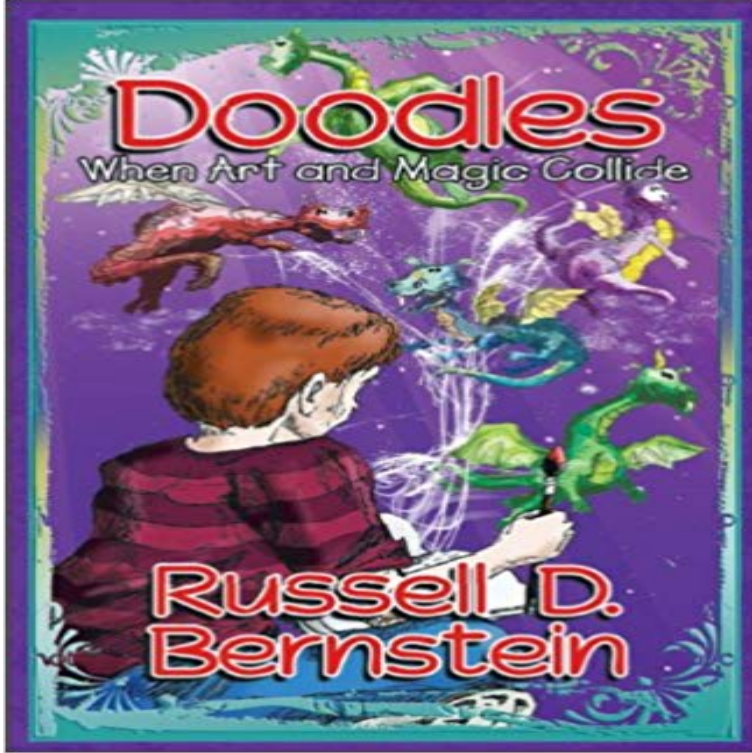


## Doodles: When Art and Magic Collide
