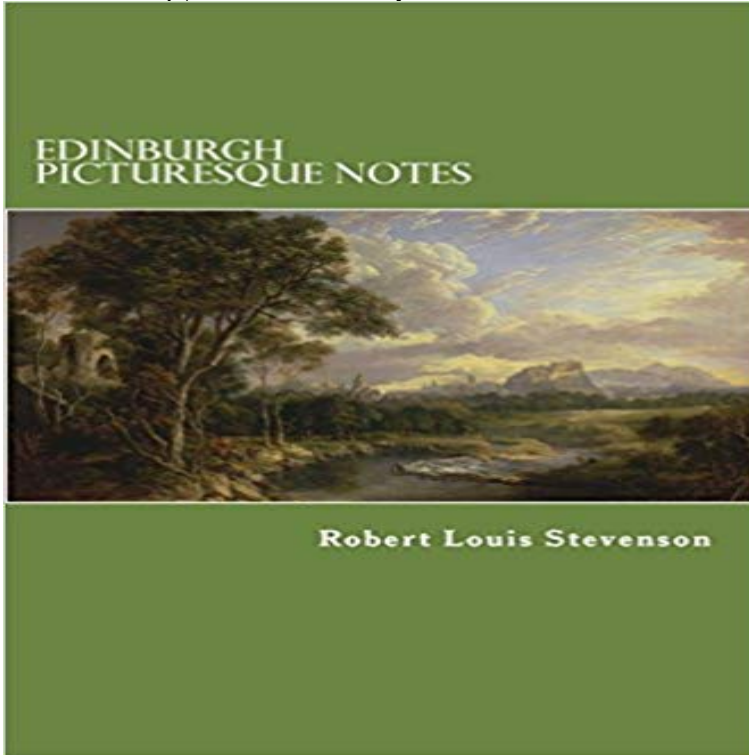


Edinburgh Picturesque Notes
