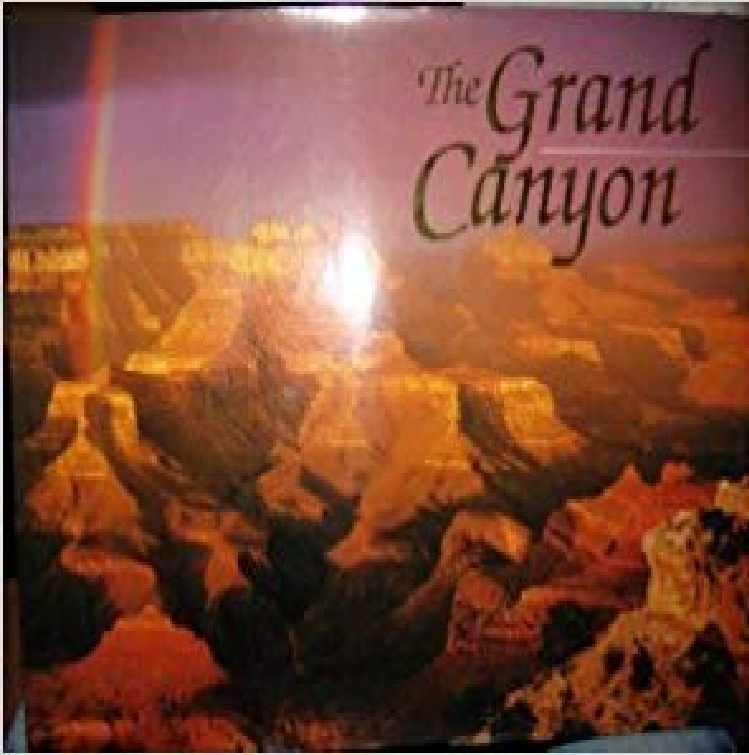


# The Grand Canyon
