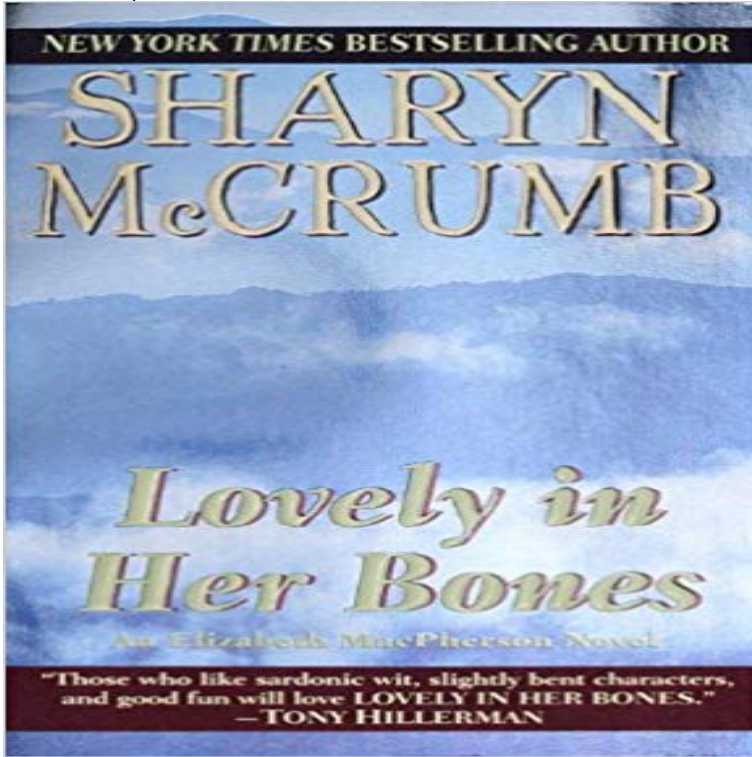


Lovely in Her Bones
