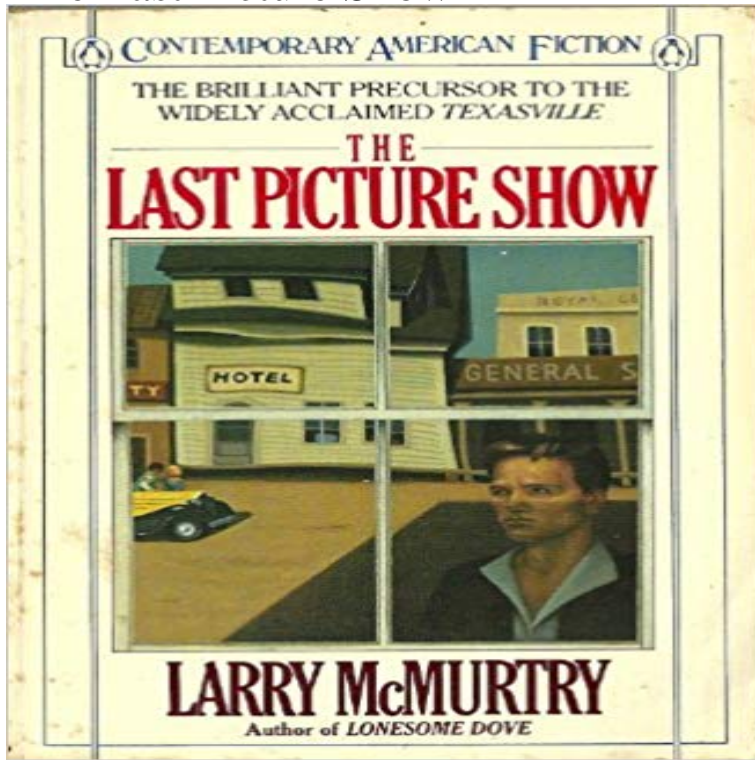


The Last Picture Show
