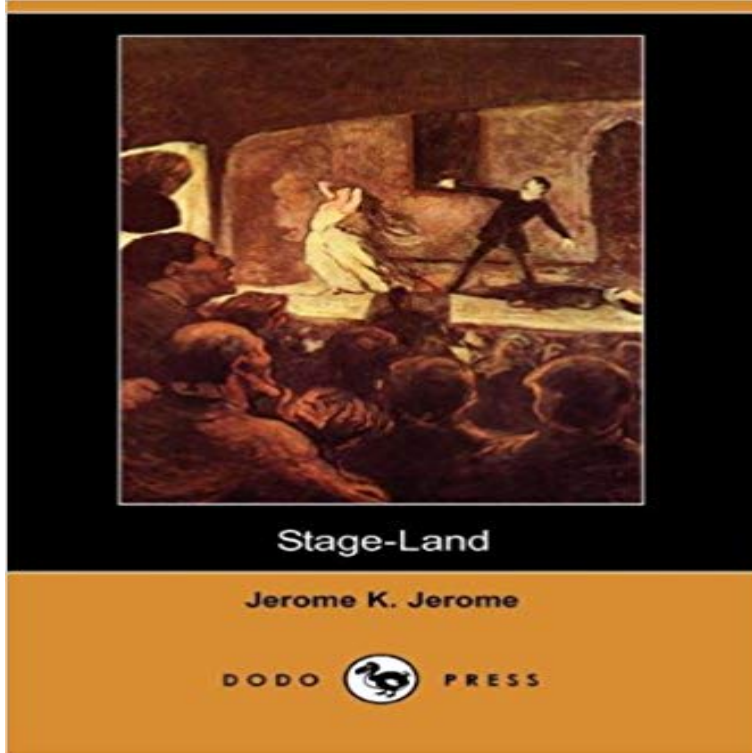


Stage-Land (Dodo Press)



Jerome Klapka Jerome (1859-1927) was an English author, best known for the humorous travelogue *Three Men in a Boat* (1889). In 1877, he decided to try his hand at acting, under the stage name Harold Crichton. He joined a repertory troupe who tried to produce plays on a shoestring budget, often drawing on the meager resources of the actors themselves to purchase costumes and props. He tried to become a journalist, writing essays, satires and short stories, but most of these were rejected. Over the next few years he was a school teacher, a packer, and a solicitors clerk. Finally, in 1885, he had some success with *On the Stage and Off*, a humorous book, the publication of which opened the door for more plays and essays.
