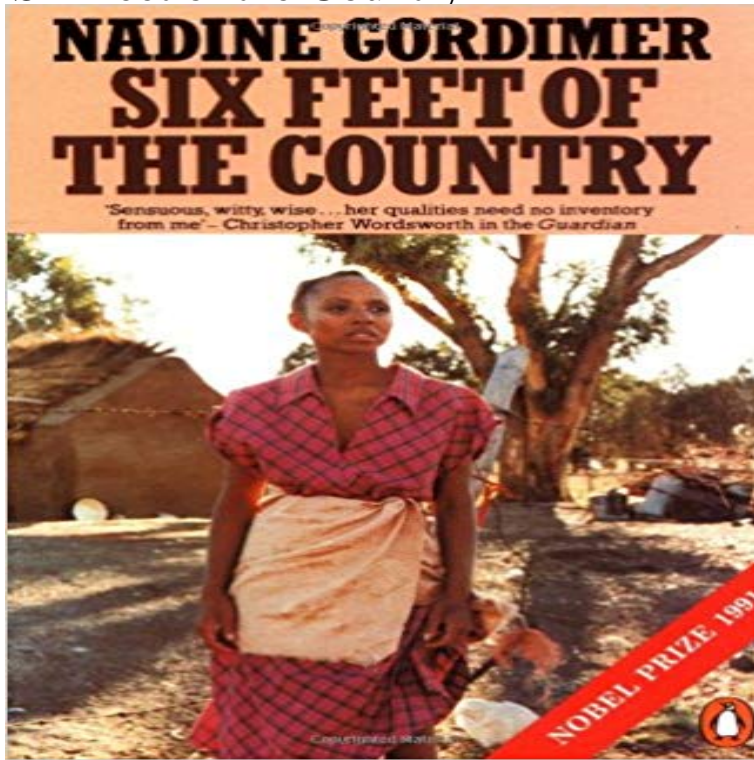


Six Feet of the Country
