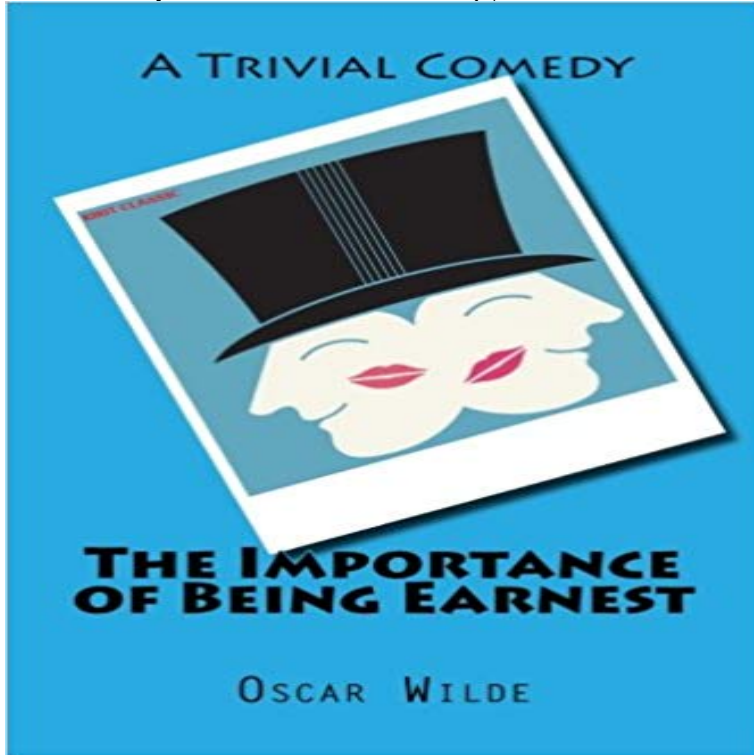


The Importance of Being Earnest
