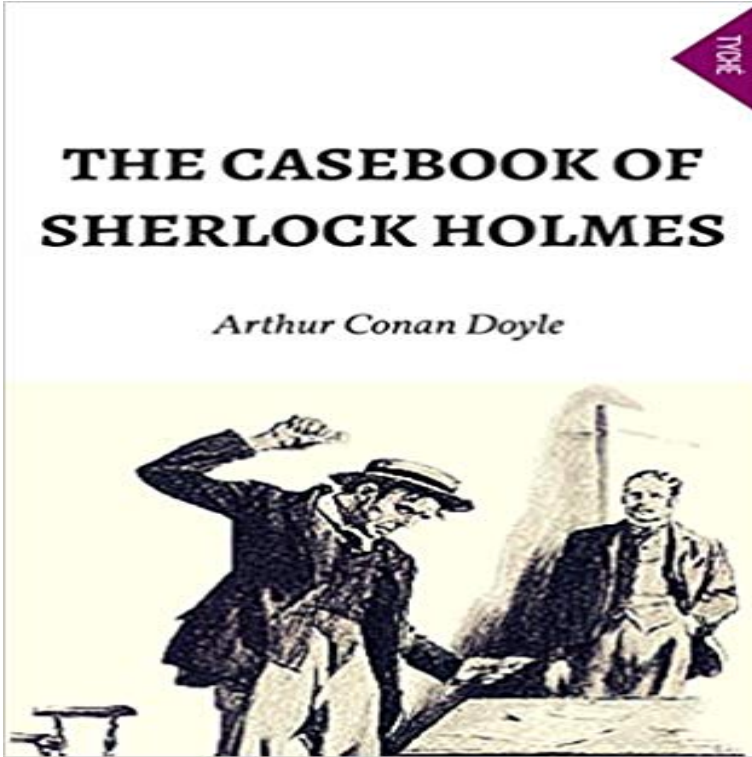


The Casebook Of Sherlock Holmes
