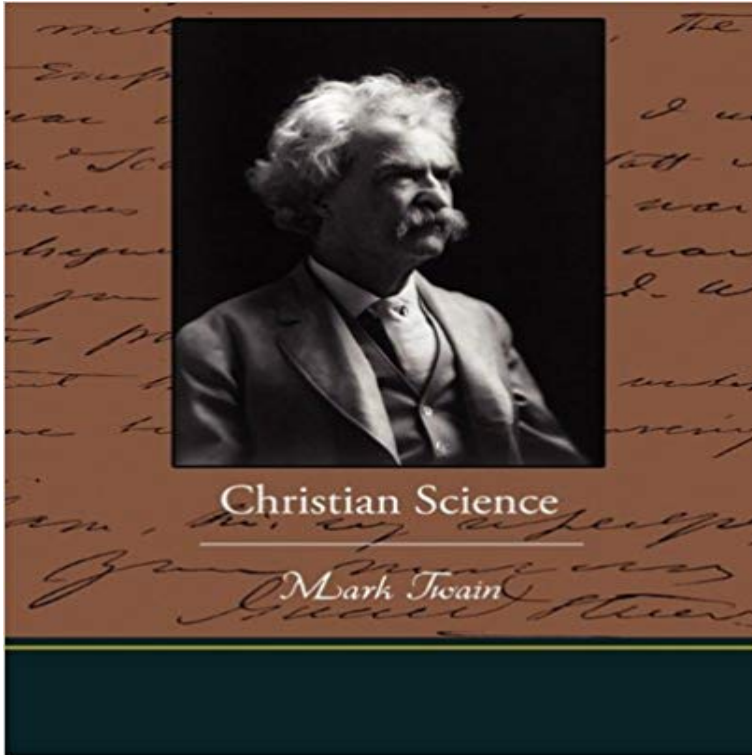


# Christian Science

Inspired by her own experience A Christian Science Reading Room is a place operated as a public service by a Christian Science church in the community where that church exists.
