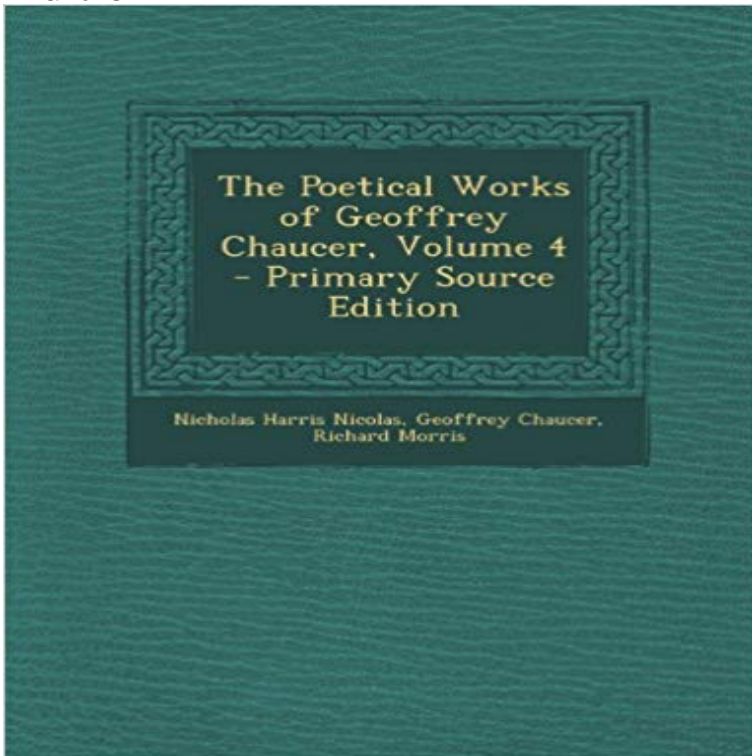


The Poetical Works of Geoffrey Chaucer, Volume 4 - Primary Source Edition
