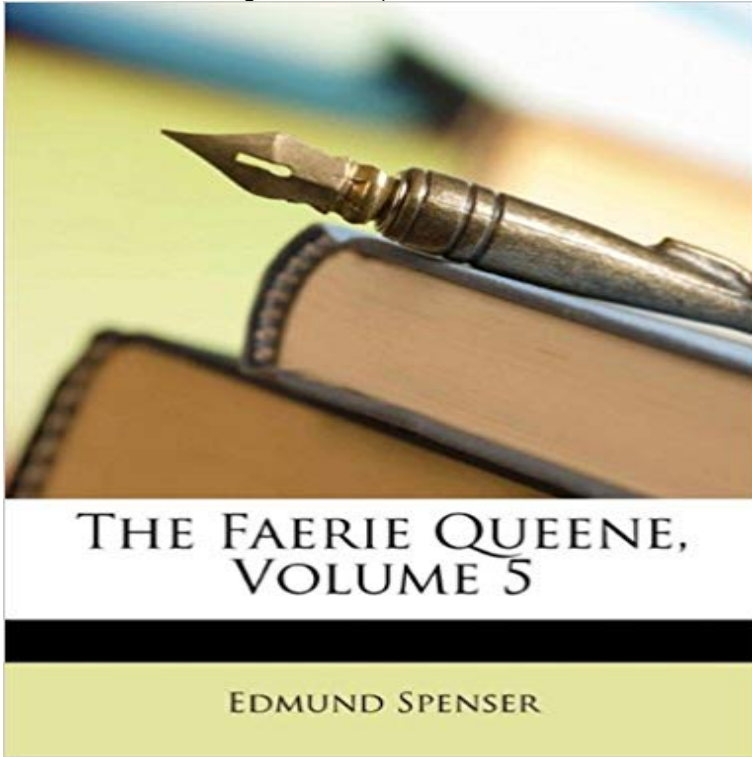


The Faerie Queene, Volume 5
