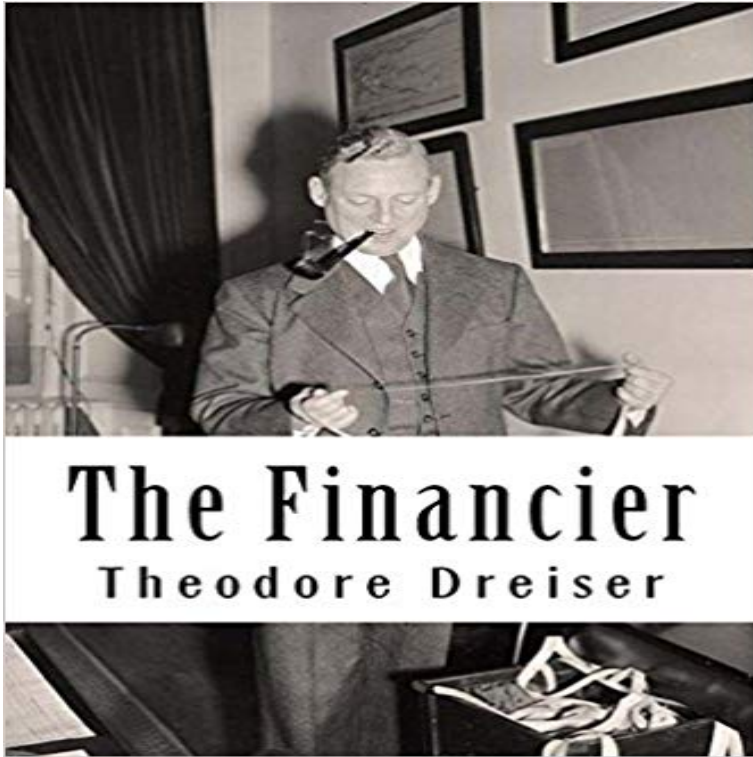


The Financier
