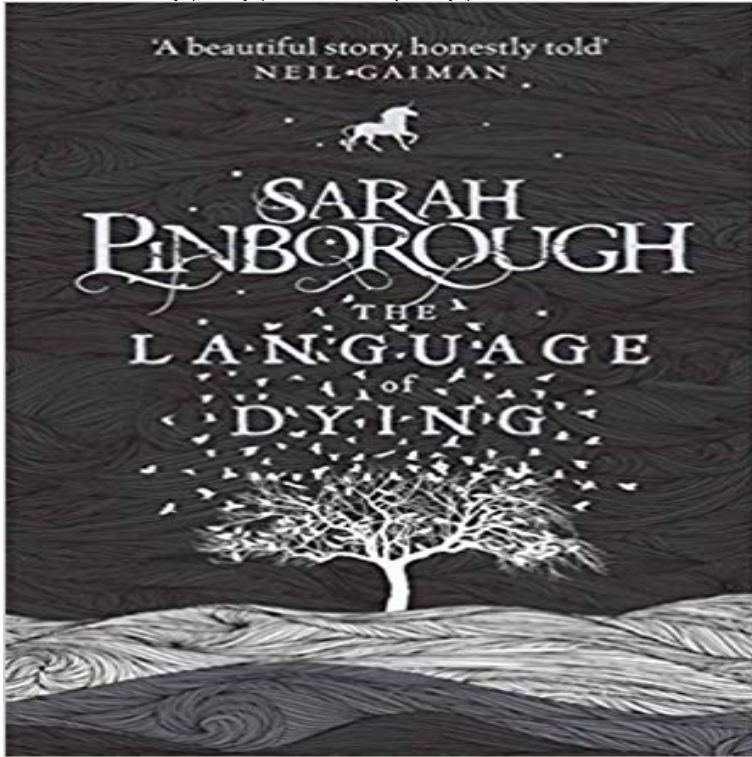


# The Language of Dying
