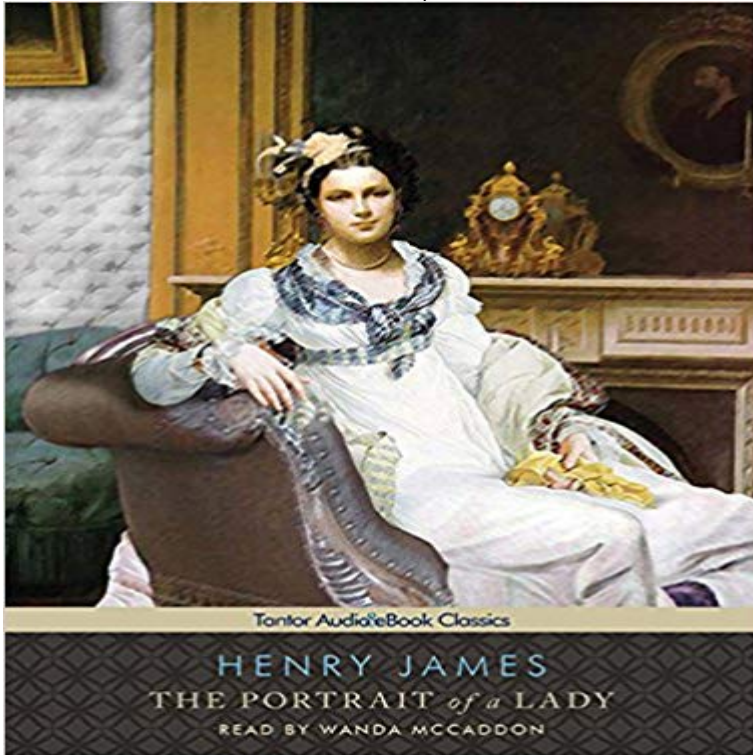


The Portrait of a Lady
