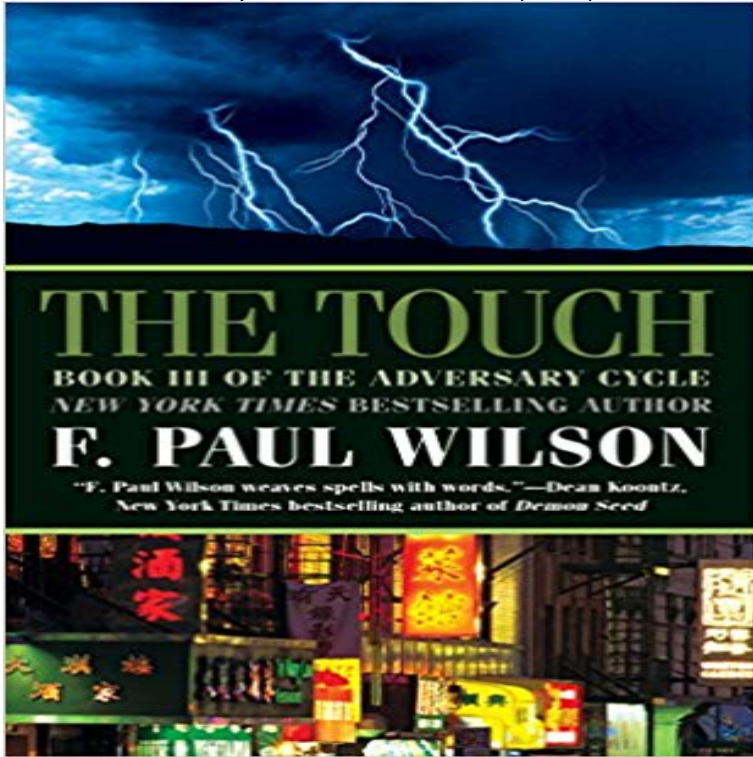


The Touch (The Adversary Cycle Book 3)
