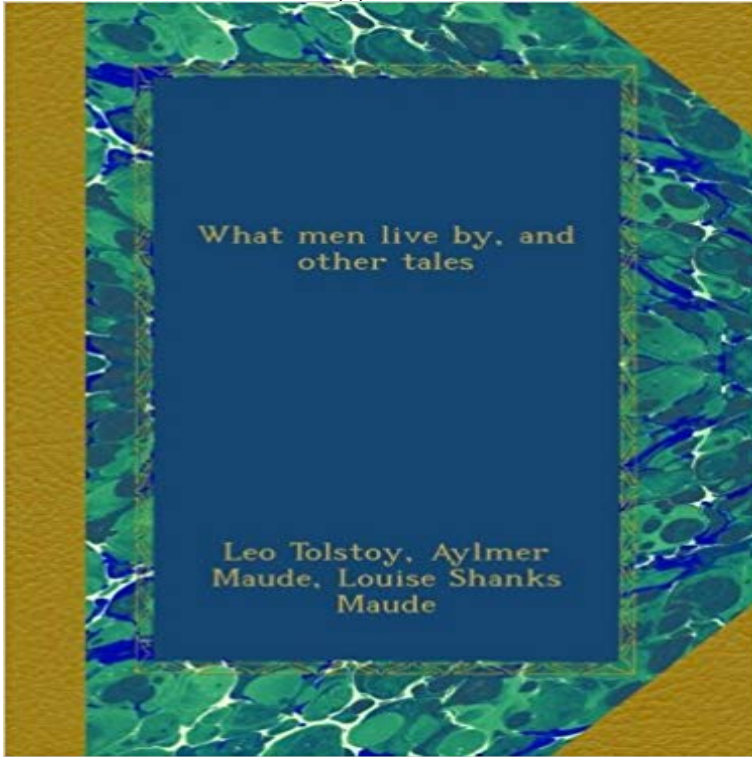


What men live by, and other tales
