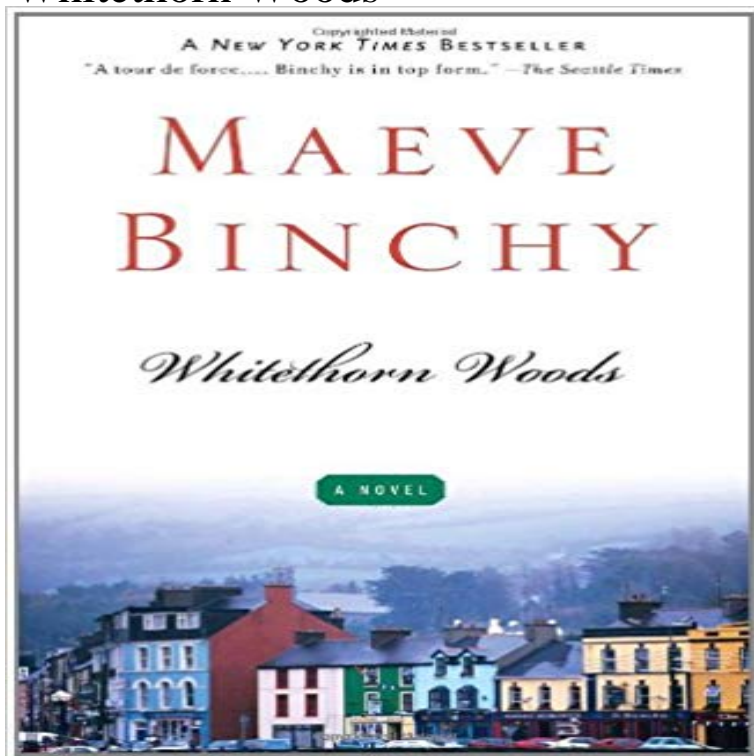


Whitethorn Woods
